Scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors on the basis of academic background, a 500 word essay, a letter of recommendation, and a personal interview.

- A Graduating Senior from a Public High School in the Central Savannah River Area with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Will attend an accredited vocational or academic 2 or 4 year institution as a full time student.

- Provide documented proof of participation in extracurricular activities, either school sponsored or of value to the community.
- May qualify and accept the HOPE Scholarship or PELL Grant in addition to the Sergeants Major Retired Educational Scholarship.
- Submit a completed Sergeants Major Retired Scholarship Application Package by Tuesday, April 30, 2019.
